- 4. LITERARY WORK:** Technical correctness of the literary work shows understanding of your question by using directive / Task words (Discuss, Analysis, Evaluate, Assess, Examine etc.)

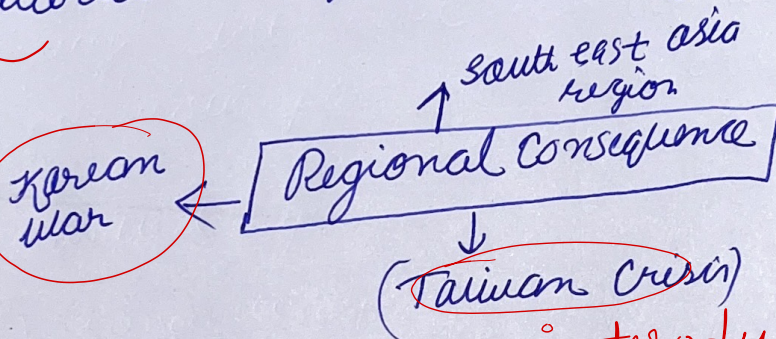

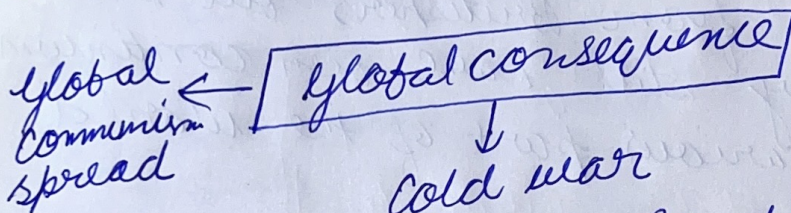
① Taiwan Crisis: winning of communist party led to retreat of Nationalist Government of Taiwan

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① Southeast Asia : This revolution has encouraged communist movement in Vietnam, Laos, Cambodia
(eg) Vietnam war. → It is well written manner

① Cold war Revolution : Revolution intensified the cold war tensions with China supporting U.S.S.R
(eg) Sino-Soviet split 1960s

② Global communism spread in various part of African countries and Central America

(eg) China supporting African countries like Ethiopia, Angola
