4. **LITERARY WORK:** Technical correctness of the literary work shows understanding of your question by using directive / Task words (Discuss, Analysis, Evaluate, Assess, Examine etc.)

events that led to Quit India movement  $\rightarrow$

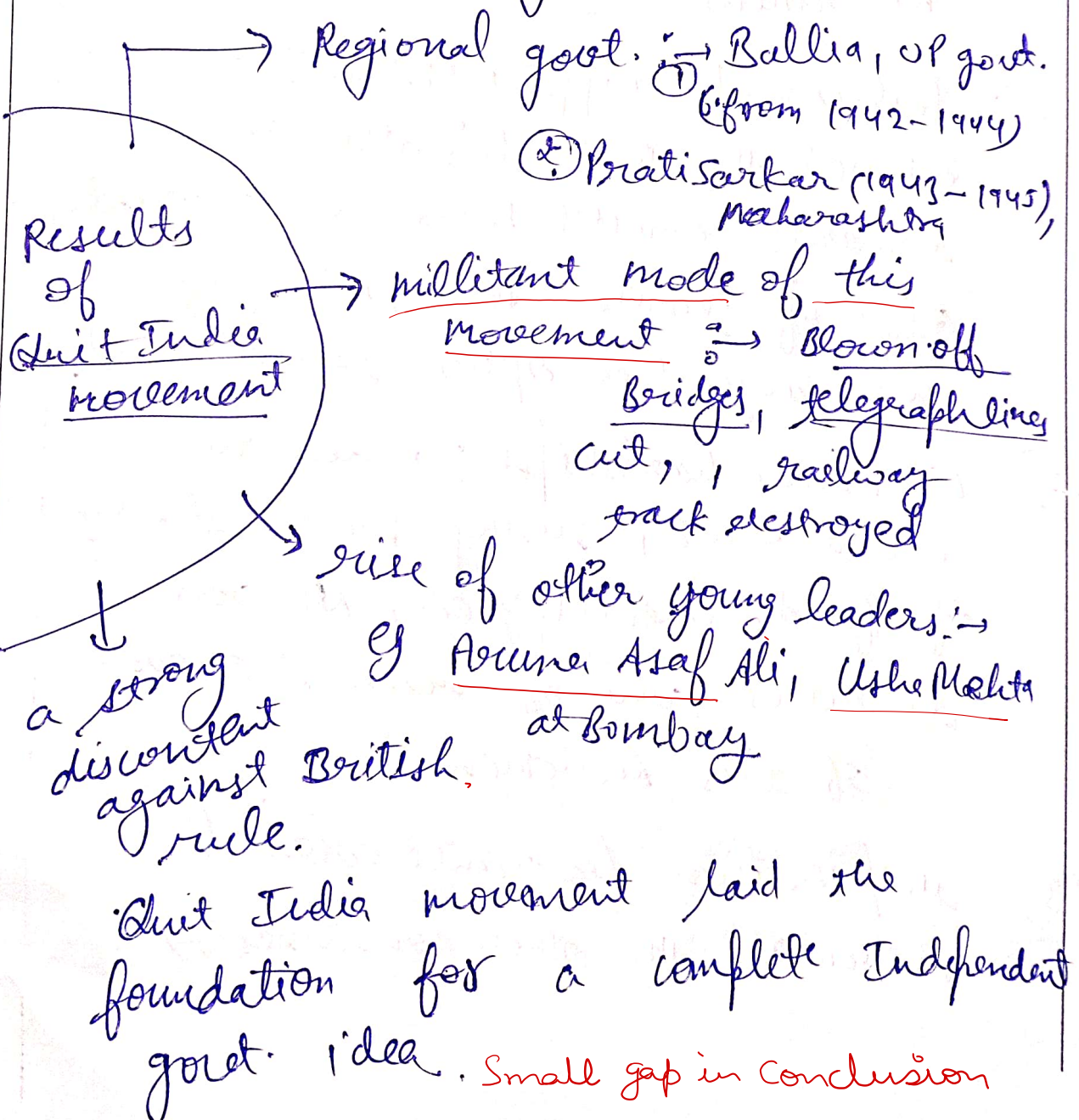

- ③ inspiration from anti colonial movement in other countries  $\rightarrow$



anti-imperialism movement and growth of European power by asian power shattered white prestige.

④ No consultation with congress leaders for participation of India in world war II.

⑤ Invasion of Japan on South East Asia, made leaders to make self defense against fascism.
